Hey, families! Here's a look at what we're covering with your kids this month so you can help your kids continue growing at home during the week.

GROW AT HOME THIS MONTH

WEEK 1

This week, kids learn from this week's psalm that worship can look like **waiting in hope**.

- **BIG IDEA:** We can worship by putting our hope in God.
- **BIBLE:** Psalm 33:12-22; Hebrews 11:1-3
- **ASK THIS:** Read Psalm 33:20. What does it mean to "wait in hope for the Lord?" How can you worship God every day this week?

WEEK 2

This week, kids learn from this week's psalm that worship includes **asking God for help**.

- **BIG IDEA:** We can worship by asking for God's help.
- **BIBLE:** Psalm 80:8-19; Hebrews 12:1-2
- **ASK THIS:** What are some things Asaph asked God to help with? Do you think it's hard or easy to ask for help? Why?

WEEK 3

This week, kids learn from this week's psalm that a big part of worship is **remembering God's faithfulness**.

- **BIG IDEA:** We can worship by remembering what God has done.
- **BIBLE:** Psalm 103:1-8; Hebrews 12:28-29
- **ASK THIS:** Read Psalm 103:2 What are some of the things God has done for us? What is one thing you can do to make sure you don't forget the things God had done for you?

WEEK 4

This week, kids learn from this week's psalm that worship is all about how we **live for God**.

- **BIG IDEA:** We can worship by living for God.
- **BIBLE:** Psalm 112; Hebrews 13:1-3
- **ASK THIS:** What are some examples of living for God that we see in this Psalm? Is it possible to worship God without living for God? How come?

MEMORY VERSE: " I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful, I know that full well." — Psalm 139:14 (NIV)
