




## What are Community Groups?

## Jesus:

 How does the group apply God's Word specifically to their lives?

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

5min after — Pray and eat

30min after — Worship

**40min after** — CG Outline Discussion

1hr20min after — Prayer requests & prayer

### ACTIVELISTENING

- Reflect "what I heard you say was"
- Question "tell me more about that"
- Understand "help me understand"
- Validate "that makes sense"
- Care "it matters that you feel that way"





## CONFLICTRESOLUTION

- Goal is unity and peace (Rom.12:18)
- Check your own emotional state (Eph. 4:31)
- Curiosity (James 1:19)
- Find solution that leads to growth & health (Rom. 14:19)
- Follow the process in Matthew 18



## Process of Conflict Resolution



15 "If your brother or sister sins, go and point out their fault, just between the two of you. If they listen to you, you have won them over. 16 But if they will not listen, take one or two others along, so that 'every matter may be established by the testimony of two or three witnesses." 17 If they still refuse to listen, tell it to the church; and if they refuse to listen even to the church, treat them as you would a pagan or a tax collector. Matt. 18:15-17

## Ways to care for those in need:

- See the hurt/need
- Move in
- Listen with compassion
- Pray take this cup, your will be done





#### CRISIS CARE

## When to refer for further help:

- Talk or self-harm, abuse, or addiction
- You sense you are not able or trained on the issues
- After you meet many times with no/minimal improvement
- You realize there is a systematic issue that needs to be addressed (marital or family)
- The person or their issues push your buttons and impede your ability to show compassion and empathy
