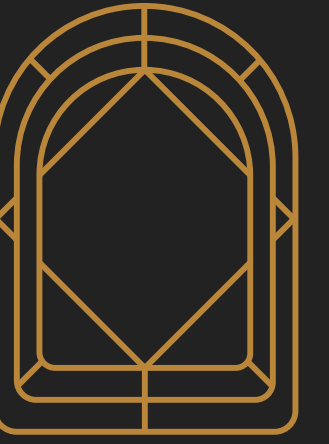

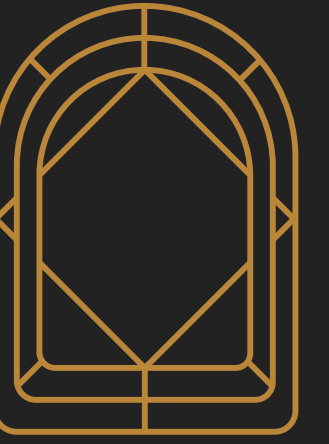

Ten Commandments

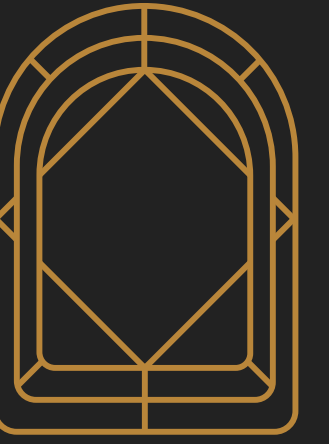


1. No other gods before me

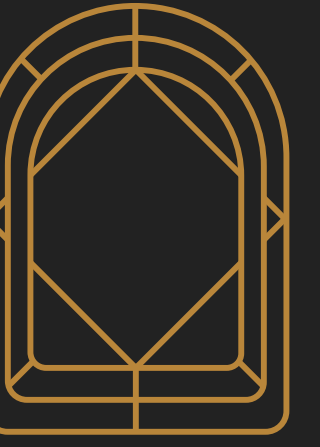


6. Do not murder

10. Do not covet

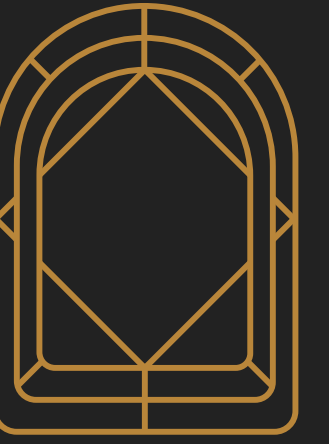

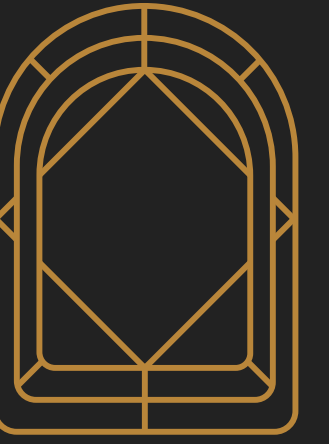


¹⁹ honor your father and mother,' and 'love your neighbor as yourself.'" ²⁰ "All these I have kept," the young man said. "What do I still lack?"
